

# ST. PETER'S PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

## MINUTES SEPTEMBER 3, 2020

Meeting was called to order by Father Biju and we opened with a prayer led by Father Biju.

We did not have copies of the meeting minutes of our last meeting, so we started with discussions based on the agenda provided by Father Biju.

- The old well in the basement of the church was repaired and all approvals for its use have been granted from the State. This represents a considerable savings to the parish since no new well had to be drilled.
- The parking lot around the church has been chip sealed. This project was completed in the last week of August 2020.
- The Annual Parish Corporation Board Meeting will be held on September 22, 2020 (conference call) at St. Joseph Parish. Ann Hundt will attend this meeting.
- The Blessing of the rectory, which has undergone significant repairs, is scheduled for September 13 after mass. All are welcome to attend and tour the rectory at that time.
- The Sauerkraut Dinner is scheduled for October 14, 2020 from 4:00 pm to 7:30 pm. This year will be “drive up” only due to COVID concerns.
- Installation of Father Biju as our pastor will be held on Saturday October 4, 2020 at the 8:30 mass at St. Joseph Ridge Parish. Very Rev. William A. Dhein V.G. presiding.
- Mission appeal will be the weekend of September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.
- It was decided that home visits and communion will continue to be on hold unless a specific home visit request is made to Father Biju.
- A resumption of Mass Obligation will begin on October 4, 2020.
- Reports;
  - Religious Education – First Communion and Confirmations were held this year and CCD education has begun for this school year.
  - PCCW – Will assist at the rectory open house
  - Cemetery – Boundary survey needs to be completed for possible expansion.
- Next meeting date was set for Tuesday November 10, 2020 at 6:00 pm.

Meeting was closed with a prayer let by Father Biju.
